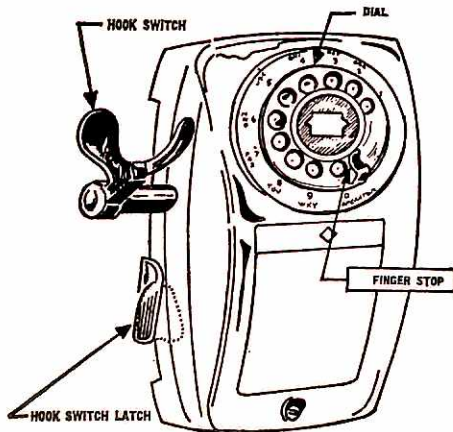
HOW TO USE THE DIAL TELEPHONE

Exchange Customers:

- 1. REMOVE THE RECEIVER**—Be careful not to move the hook at any time during the call.
- 2. LISTEN FOR THE DIAL TONE**—A steady humming sound, indicating that the equipment is ready for you to dial.
- 3. WHAT TO DIAL**—It is necessary to dial each figure of the number in rotation.
- 4. HOW TO DIAL**—Suppose you are calling 578-5678. To dial this number proceed as follows:
 - (1) Remove receiver and listen for the dial tone.
 - (2) Place your finger in the hole over the figure "5".
 - (3) Turn the dial around until your finger strikes the finger stop, then lift your finger and allow the dial to return to rest without touching it.
 - (4) Repeat this operation for the figures 78-5678. If you find you have made an error before you have completed dialing, hang up the receiver for a few seconds, then remove the receiver, listen for the dial tone, and after hearing it, dial your call again.
- 5. AFTER YOU HAVE FINISHED TALKING**—Hang up the receiver—this will disconnect you from the called telephone. Leave your receiver on the hook for a few seconds before starting to make another call.

Rural Customers:

A GUIDE TO THE USE OF YOUR AUTOMATIC PARTY LINE TELEPHONES



- 1. TO CALL EXCHANGE SUBSCRIBERS AND OTHER PARTY LINE SUBSCRIBERS:**
 - (a) Lift the receiver. If the line is free, press the Hook Switch Latch.
 - (b) Listen for dial tone, then dial the number as listed in the directory.
- 2. TO CALL A SUBSCRIBER ON YOUR OWN LINE:**
 - (a) Lift the receiver. If the line is free, press the Hook Switch Latch.
 - (b) Listen for dial tone, then dial the number as listed in the directory.
 - (c) When you hear the busy signal, depress the Hook Switch until the Hook Switch Latch releases and listen.
 - (d) When your party answers, press the Hook Switch Latch and proceed with your conversation.

IF THE CALLED PARTY DOES NOT ANSWER:
Press the Hook Switch Latch to stop the ringing and then replace the receiver.



- 1. TO CALL EXCHANGE SUBSCRIBERS AND OTHER PARTY LINE SUBSCRIBERS:**
 - (a) Lift the receiver. If the line is free, pull up the "Call" button.
 - (b) Listen for dial tone, then dial the number as listed in the directory.
- 2. TO CALL A SUBSCRIBER ON YOUR OWN LINE:**
 - (a) Lift the receiver. If the line is free, pull up the "Call" button.
 - (b) Listen for dial tone, then dial the number as listed in the directory.
 - (c) When you hear the busy signal, depress the hook switch until the "Call" button releases and listen.
 - (d) When your party answers, pull up the "Call" button and proceed with your conversation.

IF THE CALLED PARTY DOES NOT ANSWER:
Pull up the "Call" button to stop the ringing and then replace the receiver.

If you have any difficulty placing a call, or need assistance, dial "0" (Zero).
